Re: Interpretation of §36-25-6-1. Designated Areas of Safety 6.1. When in the vicinity of a switch, all persons shall get into an area of safety, either in a shelter hole or a crosscut, when trips are approaching.

This is a notice to provide the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training Director's interpretation of the above Board of Coal Mine Health and Safety Rule §35-25-6-1. "When trips are approaching" means any on-rail/track mobile equipment such as rail-mantrips, locomotives and rail cars, rail-mounted roof bolt machines and any other types of transportation equipment that may be traveling in the track entry.
